What a year! LBC provided eight overnight camps and four weeks of day camps throughout the summer. (These are concurrent, and reflect the amazingness of our staff!) We broke a record this summer, serving 596 campers - our highest ever! Record numbers and record enthusiasm reaffirmed for us what we already knew - we require a new dining hall that can serve more campers, more staff, and more people who love LBC. Usually there is a bit of reprieve for staff and the board after camp winds down for the summer, but not this year! The dining hall was filled with folks one last time on August 27th for our successful Last Supper fundraiser, emptied on the 28th, and demolished on the 31st. In total, we had 596 registrations! This is up by 56 from 2022.






